- o **Do Not Throw Any Items from Units - Throwing candy or any other objects from an entry are strictly prohibited!** We want to have a fun and SAFE parade. Children will and do run in between units to get candy without regard to the next oncoming unit. You may have walkers alongside your entry handing out giveaways. **Note: Walkers must walk by the edge of the parade route!**
- o **Use or possession of illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages is prohibited on parade line up areas and within the parade route by parade participants. Violators will be asked to leave and will not be reimbursed of any entry fees.**
- o **Squirt guns, super soakers, etc., are not allowed.**
